## **EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION 2011 GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**

Approved by the Commission December 2, 2010

### **a) Develop Alternative Transportation Options**

- Implement El Dorado County Regional Transportation Plan 2010-2030, prepared by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission
- Support Transportation Demand Management and Alternative Transportation Options
- Conduct a needs assessment for an El Dorado Hills transit service

### **b) Coordinate with External Partners/ Agencies**

- Coordinate with SACOG
- Encourage HOV Lanes throughout the Region to decrease congestion and improve air quality
- Increase influence within El Dorado County and with regional agencies
- Coordinate with Caltrans on STIP/ SHOPP Projects within El Dorado County
- Encourage Caltrans to perform vegetation management on SR 49 and US 50
- Coordinate with Caltrans to develop a grade separated alternative to the intersection of SR 49 and US 50
- Support Project Delivery Teams and monitor regionally significant transportation projects (STIP, SHOPP, CMIA, MTIP, CMAQ, RSTP, TEA) within El Dorado County

### **c) Cultivate Outreach and Public Involvement Plan**

- Utilize local newspapers for ongoing press coverage
- Maintain Website
- Ensure continued public participation in transportation planning
- Forward Advisory Committee applicants to Commission for appointment/ ratification
- Produce EDCTC Newsletter/ Annual Report
