Dear Assembly Member Huber,

The El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC), at the June 4 Commission meeting, approved the solicitation of membership applications for the EDCTC Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC). The one purpose of the CAC is to review the current composition of the Commission and provide a recommendation with respect to the future composition of EDCTC with input from residents throughout the county. The Commission will make appointments in a fashion that will assure representation from throughout the Western Slope of El Dorado County. The EDCTC also directed that the CAC hold approximately six public meetings at various locations throughout the Western Slope of El Dorado County to accomplish this goal.

At the June 4 meeting Commission meeting, Commissioner Acuna also requested that EDCTC consider adopting a resolution expressing opposition to Assembly Bill No. 1204; however, that resolution was withdrawn from consideration by Commissioner Acuna. The Commission stated that the withdrawal of the resolution of opposition was based on the amendments to Assembly Bill No. 1204 presented at the June 4 Commission meeting by your Legislative Director.
