RESOLUTION 08/09.19

RESOLUTION OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ALLOCATING FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUNDS

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission is the regional transportation planning agency for the Western Slope of El Dorado County and responsible for the administration of the Transportation Development Act of 1971, as amended thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado, the City of Placerville, and the El Dorado County Transit Authority are each required to file annual transportation claims for the funds, if any, from the Local Transportation Fund of the Western Slope of the County, as apportioned to them by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission, pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the El Dorado County Transportation Commission, under the provisions of the Act, to review the annual transportation claims and to make allocations of monies from the Local Transportation Fund based on the estimated revenue upon approving said claim; and

WHEREAS, the Auditor of said County is instructed to pay monies in the fund to the claimants pursuant to allocation instructions received from the El Dorado County Transportation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Transportation Commission shall review the claims as they are received, approve same for the 2009/2010 Fiscal Year funds estimated to be available in the Local Transportation Fund, and make the following allocations:

1. To the County of El Dorado Auditor-Controller for administrative costs, to be paid only once from the entire County's fund prior to apportioning the County Local Transportation Fund in the amount of \$4,000.00, per Section 99233.1.
2. To the El Dorado County Transportation Commission for TDA administration and for planning and programming in the amount of \$363,190.87, per Section 99233.2.
3. To the El Dorado County Transportation Commission for reservation for pedestrian and bicycle facilities purposes for local agencies as programmed and claimed in the amount of \$64,480.48, per Sections 99233.3 and 99234.
4. To the El Dorado County Transit Authority for Article 4 purposes, the total amount available of \$3,363,175.65, per Sections 99233.8, 99260(a), and 99262.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission has requested that approved claims are to be paid in full, provided the funds are available, and provided that the Commission has properly expended prior Local Transportation Funds at the beginning of the Fiscal Year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that allocation instructions shall be prepared for each claimant in accordance with the above, and pursuant to the El Dorado County Transportation Commission rules and regulations. The Executive Director, appointed by the Commission, is authorized to sign the allocation instructions and to issue the instructions to the County Auditor to pay the claimants in accordance with the above allocations and conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the claimants are to be notified by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission of action on their claims.


