Residents can have input into transportation projects

El Dorado County residents can have a say on who oversees planning and programming of funds for transportation projects on the county's western slope.

The El Dorado County Transportation Commission is accepting applications for a citizens advisory committee. Members will be appointed in a manner that assures representation from throughout the area the commission serves.

Applications are available on the commission's Web site at www.edctc.org or may be requested by calling (530) 642-5260.

The committee will hold a half-dozen meetings in various communities to solicit public comment and make recommendations regarding composition of the Transportation Commission.

The panel currently consists of three members each from the county Board of Supervisors and the Placerville City Council, the two elected bodies that oversee road construction and maintenance on the county's western slope.
